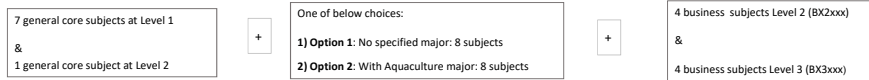


STUDY PLAN FOR BACHELOR OF BUSINESS & ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES
