IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

- You are required to come to examination **venue at least 30 minutes before the published start time.**
- Candidates granted Supplementary Examination (FSE) are required to pay Supplementary Exam fees. Please refer to the email that has been sent to the student's JCU Singapore email address. This does NOT apply to Deferred Examination (ED)/Special Examination.
- This examination is to be conducted at James Cook University (Singapore campus) and all the timing indicate here is based on **Singapore Time.**

ABSENCE FROM EXAMINATION

- If student does not sit the supplementary examination, a subject result of F (fail) is awarded.
- If student does not sit the deferred examination, a subject result of F (fail) or X (fail) is awarded.
- Misreading the exam timetable, claiming travel bookings are made or leaving on a holiday prior to the completion of the exam period are unjustifiable reasons for absence of exam.**

EXAMINATION RULES

- Candidates who require to use Respondus in their own laptop during examination, will need to download and test the Respondus a few days before the final examination date.
- Candidate who does not arrive within the timetabled entry time for an Examination at a JCU Study Site, will receive an outcome of DNS (did not submit).
- For Online Respondus Examination (on campus), access to the examination room is **not allowed** after the published start time.
- For Hard Copy Exam, access to the examination room is allowed up to 30 minutes after the published start time. There is no time extension given for late comer.
- Candidates **must** bring their JCU **Student ID card** to all examinations and placed them at top right hand corner of their examination desks at the commencement of each examination.
- Candidates need to familiarise themselves with the Permitted Materials for each Examination, including whether any books or pre-prepared notes are permitted.
- Do not share Permitted Materials with other candidates during the Examination or bringing any non-permitted materials into the Examination
- Do not communicate with any person or thing that is not the Examination Supervisor, a JCU Staff member, an approved Reader and Scribe. This also applies during any temporary absence from the examination room during the Examination.
- If a candidate would like to communicate with the Examination Supervisor, the candidate would need to raise his/her hand and remain seated.
- Candidates to bring their own stationery (example: pens, pencils, ruler and erasers) for an Examination where needed to perform the Examination.
- NO sharing of calculators (where applicable), pens or other materials between candidates. Exam Office WILL NOT provide any stationery for the Examination.
- NO unauthorised book, paper, document or picture may be taken by any candidate into or out of an examination hall. Candidates must read and understand the WARNING Notice printed at the back of the exam booklet to avoid any breach of the University's 'Student Academic Misconduct Requirements'
- Writings found on student body part during the examination might be subjected to Academic Misconduct.
- Food is not allowed in the examination room. Only clear unlabelled water bottles are allowed.
- Watches of any types ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED to be worn during the exams. Watches have to be removed and keep in the bags. Watches cannot be placed on the table.
- Smart glasses are not allowed in the examination hall.
- Mobile phones (unless is required during the exam), pagers, watches, smart watches, electronic dictionaries, if brought in, must be switched off and placed in the candidate bag.
- Caps or hats are not allow to be worn during examination, unless religious head coverings such as turbans/hijabs.
- Do not bring any valuables with you when you come for the exam. Under no circumstances should you leave any valuables unattended in any bag, JCU will not be liable for the loss of the valuables.
