Medical Check-up & Student Pass Formalities

Student ID Card

The card is a must for all students who are physically studying in Singapore. You will need one to enter the campus, borrow materials from the library, attend exams, reserve facilities, and access <u>discounts and offers</u> from businesses across Singapore. You should be able to collect the card upon receiving an email from the Student Affairs department.

Email Account

Your JCU email account is your primary source of communication. Check it regularly to ensure you receive official communications such as your classes, enrolment, fees, or academic progression. You should already have your JCU email address. If not, please access <u>JCU GetStarted</u> to create an account. You are required to have your 8 digit Student ID ready for this process.
