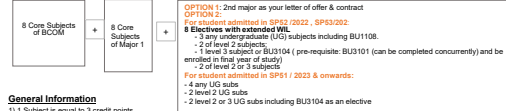

Overlapping subjects for double majors:

For student under ITD & BKF / BKF & ITD / ITD & ECN / ECN & ITD: There is an overlap of 1 subject. Student will take either BX2053 OR 1 subject from any undergraduate program.

For student under ITD & FMA / FMA & ITD / BKF & ECN / ECN & BKF / FMA & ECN / ECN & FMA: There are an overlap of 2 subjects. Student will take either

(1) BX2053 PLUS 1 subject from any undergraduate program OR (2) 2 subjects from any undergraduate program.

For student under ACC & FMA / ACC & ECN: BX3033 under FMA or ECN major is for Non Acc students only. Hence, BX3033 will be removed for students under ACC & FMA or ACC & ECN majors. Student will take the 9 core subjects from ACC major PLUS the remaining 7 subjects from FMA / ECN major.
