A book in a multivolume work	Author's family name. Then year of publication in parenthesis. Then book title in letter caps and italics, volume number in parenthesis. Then publisher	Saichev, A. I., & Woyczynski, W. A. (2018). <i>Distributions in the physical and engineering sciences</i> (Vol. 3). Birkhäuser. [Source: Printed book, no online access]
A book translated from another language	Author's family name. Then year of publication in parenthesis. Then book title in letter caps and italics, with translator's name in parenthesis. Then publisher. Then year of publication of original work in parenthesis	Murakami, H. (2000). <i>Norwegian wood</i> (J. Rubin, Trans.). Vintage International. (Original work published 1987). [Source: Printed book, no online access]
