CONTINUOUS LEARNING SCHEME– TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This scheme offers a two subject tuition fee relief for current students of JCU including Undergraduate Study Abroad students studying a minimum of four subjects who seek to progress from a Bachelor's Degree to a Master's Degree at the Singapore campus of James Cook University, except for Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours) to Master of Psychology (Clinical). The scheme also offers tuition fee relief of 16% of the total course fee for Doctor of Philosophy and Master of Philosophy for current students of JCU seeking to progress to Doctor of Philosophy or Master of Philosophy. Other levels of progression are not eligible for this scheme.
2. Students applying for this scheme must commence the Master's Degree or Doctor of Philosophy at the Singapore campus of James Cook University within five years of the completion of the program they are progressing from.
3. Students with credit exemptions must study a minimum of eight subjects in an applicable Master's Degree at the Singapore campus of James Cook University to obtain fee relief as part of this scheme. For Doctor of Philosophy and Master of Philosophy the fee relief will be applied up to the maximum candidature period of study.
4. The fee relief is deducted from the total tuition fee which is then divided equally by the number of instalments to determine the amount payable at the beginning of each term.
5. Students will need to pay for the cost of re-module.
6. Should a student who has been awarded fee relief under this scheme subsequently elect to transfer to another campus of the University, the fee relief will no longer be applicable.
7. Students applying for this scheme will have their application fee waived. The application must be a direct application and not submitted through an education agent.
8. For international students, the scheme is subject to the holder meeting the usual requirements of the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority of Singapore.
9. All international students registering with and receiving an offer from the Singapore campus of James Cook University are required to pay the International Student Registration Fee of S\$856 (inclusive of GST). The fee covers a range of services provided to international students by James Cook University.
10. This scheme is exclusive of all other schemes available at the Singapore campus of James Cook University. For example, a student who has been awarded fee relief as part of this scheme cannot also seek fee relief or other benefits from alternate schemes which might from time to time be available at the Singapore campus of James Cook University (e.g. the Referral Scheme).
11. James Cook University reserves the right to amend any terms and conditions pertaining to this scheme. The decision of James Cook University's management is final.
12. These conditions will supersede all previous conditions for this scheme.
