Semi-standardised online questionnaire format, adapted and customised for each partner institution.



Students invited to feedback from **September 2020 to February 2021**.



33,306 international students and 22,409 domestic students responded from 36 universities in 12 countries.



Institution-specific results compared against comparator groups, national and international benchmarks. **Standard benchmarks are based on 2020-21 data only**.














Have some or all your studies been moved online as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic?
















How often did this institution contact you regarding COVID-19 prior to starting / resuming your studies?











Top 10 factors in study decision (All students, % Important or Very important)






Top 10 influencers - International (choice of institution)








Did you attend / participate in a formal ORIENTATION programme?








Overall, how satisfied were you with the ORIENTATION PROGRAMME?








Overall, how satisfied are you with the learning experience at this stage in the year?
















Do you ever feel particularly stressed or anxious with your life at this institution?


