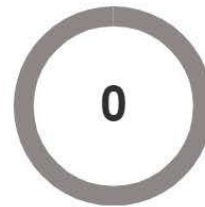

FAQs

Are the studies **safe** to participate in?

- Yes, the studies are safe to participate in as they have been reviewed by human research ethics committee (HREC).
- However, if discomfort is experienced, please notify the researchers immediately so that they can advise you on the appropriate support channels.

Can I participate and obtain credits **after** the research participation deadline?

- No. Credits obtained after the research participation deadline will not be counted.

Can I participate after obtaining the **maximum amount** of eligible credits?

- Yes! Researchers will be grateful
- However, if you are taking PY1101/PY1102 in the following trimester, do ensure that there are adequate studies available for you to attain the required credits as there is **strictly no carry over of credits** once the maximum credit is reached for the current study period/subject

Can I **share credits** among modules (e.g., 20 credits for both PY1101 and PY1102)?

- No. Credits cannot be shared between the subjects.
- Strictly 20 credits for each subject.

Can I bring over or use credits from the previous trimester?

- No. Credits cannot be brought over from the previous trimester
- Credits attained will be reset to 0 when the new trimester begins.
