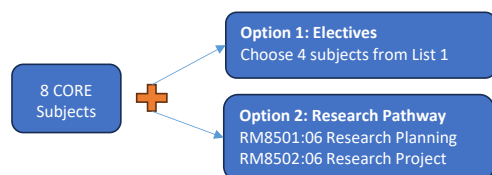


STUDY PLAN FOR MASTER OF GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING

IMPORTANT NOTE
