Physical (in Singapore)

- Student based in Singapore
- Company based in Singapore
- For Local Singaporeans/PRs:
 - No ICA/MOM restrictions
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion
- For Internationals STP/LTVP/DP holders:
 - Requires TWP/TEP processed by your Employer
 - Extension of study period
 - Internship subject must be standalone in the trimester
 - Recommend the internship to be taken in your last study period
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion

Physical (in Home Country)

- Student based in Home Country
- Company based in Home Country
- For Locals Singaporeans/PRs:
 - NA
- For Internationals STP/LTVP/DP holders:
 - Requires cancellation of Student's Pass (STP) prior to leaving Singapore
 - Extension of study period
 - Internship subject must be standalone in the trimester
 - Recommend the internship to be taken in your last study period
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion

For Locals - Singaporeans/PRs:

- No ICA/MOM restrictions
- Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion

For Internationals - STP/LTVP/DP holders:

- Can carry out internship subject alongside other subjects
- No extension of study period required
- Strictly unpaid

Virtual Based in Home Country

Student based in Singapore

For Locals - Singaporeans/PRs: NA

For Internationals - STP/LTVP/DP holders:

- Cancellation of STP
- Extension of study period
- Internship subject must be standalone in the trimester
- Recommend the internship to be taken in your last study period
- Strictly unpaid

Important Information

- The internship is a credit bearing subject thus it is important to align the internship with the academic trimester dates to ensure students keep up with the related assignments, etc.
- Internship **start date** may begin as follows:
 - Earliest: 2 weeks before the trimester start date
 - Latest: Week 2, Friday
- Internship end date as follows:
 - The credit bearing internship will end on Week 10, Friday as required for the subject assessments.
 - Internship beyond that point will be treated as an independent internship.

Availability

Internship subjects are offered every trimester.

Duration & Agreement

Internship durations generally range between 3 and 6 months.

The exact duration is agreed upon between you and your employer.

Orientation

Complete a mandatory orientation organized by your lecturer before starting your internship.

Enrollment Process

All students are initially enrolled in the applied project subject.

Only upon, successful placement will change enrolment to the internship subject.

Internship Visas (Internationals)

A work pass is required to do a physical internship in Singapore

This work pass is issued by Ministry of Manpower (MOM) in Singapore.
