Internship Modes – Physical and Virtual

Physical – Student based in Singapore / Company based in Singapore

- For Local Singaporeans/PRs:
 - No ICA/MOM restrictions
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion
- For Internationals STP/LTVP/DP holders:
 - Requires TWP/TEP processed by your Employer
 - Extension of study period
 - Internship subject must be standalone in the trimester
 - Recommend the internship to be taken in your last study period
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion

Physical – Student based in Home Country / Company based in Home Country

- For Locals Singaporeans/PRs: NA
- For Internationals STP/LTVP/DP holders:
 - For PY3201 internships, students must be based in Singapore
 - Requires cancellation of Student's Pass (STP) prior to leaving Singapore
 - Extension of study period
 - Internship subject must be standalone in the trimester
 - Recommend the internship to be taken in your last study period
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion



Internship Modes — Physical and Virtual

Virtual – Student based in Singapore / Non-Singapore company based anywhere outside Singapore

- For Locals Singaporeans/PRs:
 - No ICA/MOM restrictions
 - Can be paid or unpaid and at the Employer's discretion
- For Internationals STP/LTVP/DP holders:
 - Can remain on STP
 - Can carry out internship subject alongside other subjects
 - No extension of study period required
 - Strictly unpaid

Virtual – Student based in Home Country / Non-Singapore company based anywhere outside Singapore

- For Locals Singaporeans/PRs: NA
- For Internationals STP/LTVP/DP holders:
 - For PY3201 internships, students must be based in Singapore
 - Cancellation of STP
 - Extension of study period
 - Internship subject must be standalone in the trimester
 - Recommend the internship to be taken in your last study period
 - Strictly unpaid

- The internship is a credit bearing subject thus it is important to align the internship with the academic trimester dates
 to ensure students keep up with the related assignments, etc.
- Internship start date may begin as follows:
 - Earliest: 2 weeks before the trimester start date
 - Latest: 2 weeks after the trimester start date

Additional info

- Internship subjects are offered every trimester
- Internship durations are generally between 3 and 6 months, with the exact duration to be agreed between you and your employer
- Complete a mandatory orientation before commencing your internship and this will be organized by your subject lecturer
- Internship can be on full or part time basis
- All students will be enrolled into the applied project subject as the default, and only upon successful placement will
 your enrolment be changed to the internship subject
- Internships can only take place in Singapore or Home Country
- Application into internship subjects is a time-sensitive process: any delay in the provision of required information may lead to an unsuccessful application at the discretion of the School
- All applications are subject to prevailing regulations from Ministry of Manpower (MOM) in Singapore
- Student Careers will support the application process but does not guarantee placements
- Internship position must be in line with your current study program



Additional info (for Internationals)

- Will require a work pass in order to complete your internship in Singapore
- You must complete your work pass formalities in order to enrol in the internship subject
- Work passes are issued by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) in Singapore, and vary in relation of their terms and requirements:
 - Student's Pass holders
 - Training Employment Pass
 - Training Work Permit
 - Long-Term Visit Pass and Dependant's Pass holders
 - Please refer to the MOM <u>website</u> for detailed information
- Your employer is responsible for your work pass application and sponsorship
